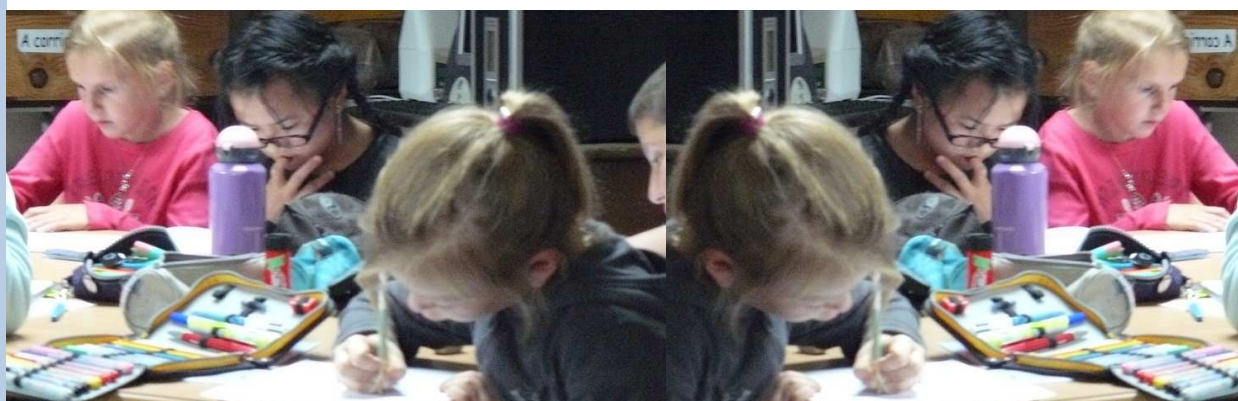


The rights and duties of a student in Belgium

We can go to the toilet without asking permission.	We have to respect the working atmosphere in the classroom.
We can drink water whenever we want without asking permission.	
When we finished an activity ahead of others we can play a board game or read.	
We can choose to make a personal project and present it to the class. We choose our own theme and the type of work (individual or collective).	We have to finish our project.
We organize the forum once a week. It allows us to give our opinion and vote for the projects discussed. This is a student who chairs the forum.	We have to respect the wordtime of each. We have to be responsible of our votes.
We learn to resolve our disputes ourselves.	We must be able to listen to others and to express ourselves on what we feel
We decorate the class together.	We have to accept the ideas of each one.
We choose our places in the class together after discussion.	Sometimes we have to accept not to get what we want
We make free homework once a month. We can choose the subject and the form.	We have to explain our project to the others.
When we have a problem with the learning, we place our individually wrapped in a container provided for that purpose, this is the signal to the teacher that we need help.	We have to accept that the teacher is responsible for someone else before we. We have to work on another schoolwork when we are waiting.
